Dear Colleagues:

As you may know from this morning's *Daily* article, an amended version of the April 14 Draft Revisions of Chapter 28 was approved yesterday by the Faculty Senate. I have outlined below the amendments that have been made to the April 14 Draft, and sincerely appreciate the effort that will be required of you to review these amendments before our Special Senate Executive Committee meeting, Monday, May 16, at 2:30 p.m. in 142 Administration. I have spoken with Professor Stevick, and he agrees that if the members of the Committee on Faculty Code and Regulations were to review this over the weekend, and would contact him (phone: 3-2153 or e-mail stevickr@u.washington.edu) by noon on Monday with comments and suggestions, he would be able to provide the Executive Committee with his advice at or before its meeting at 2:30 p.m.

Approved at the April 28, 1994, Senate Continuation Meeting:

I. Section 28.33.E. [page 8, line 17]

All Comprehensive Adjudications shall be heard by one Hearing Officer and Hearing Panel composed of five members *except that with the consent of the parties the adjudication shall be heard by the Hearing Officer without a Hearing Panel.*

Approved at the May 12, 1994, Senate Continuation Meeting:

II. Section 28.33.B. [page 6, line 25]

The Adjudication Panel shall be a standing committee consisting of (1) at least 24 members of the faculty, three from each Senate group as nominated by the Senate Executive Committee and approved by the Faculty Senate; (2) at least 6 student members selected by the ASUW and the GPSS, under procedures established by the ASUW and the GPSS in cooperation with the Chair of the Faculty Senate, and approved by the Faculty Senate; (3) at least 6 staff members selected by the University Office of Staff Personnel, under procedures established by that Office in cooperation with the various organization representing University employees, and approved by the Faculty Senate. Faculty, student and staff members of Hearing Panels for specific cases are selected from the Adjudication Panel. During the selection and appointment process for the Adjudication Panel, the commitment of the University to affirmative action and the necessity of diversity in the decision making body shall be adhered to. The Chairperson of the Adjudication Panel shall be nominated annually by the Senate executive committee from among the Adjudication Panel *faculty* members and shall be approved by the Senate. No department chairperson, school director, *assistant dean*, associate dean or dean shall serve on the
