CHAPTER 28

ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE RESOLUTION
OF DIFFERENCES

This chapter sets forth the adjudicative procedures used to resolve disputes involving faculty members that cannot be resolved by the conciliatory process. Informal dispute resolution procedures, including the Conciliation procedure through the Ombudsman's office, are available at any time during the resolution process, including the time period after a hearing has been requested and before a final decision has been reached, and the parties are encouraged to use those procedures whenever possible. ~~The adjudicatory procedures are made available to a faculty member under the circumstances described in sections 25-62, and _____, the circumstances described in Chapter _____ regarding scientific misconduct, and in the circumstances described below.~~ These procedures comply with the requirements of the Washington Administrative Procedure Act
